

## Random Drug Testing Program

When a defendant is released with the condition of drug testing and treatment, they are enrolled into the Random Drug Testing Program (RDTP).

The defendant is assigned a RDTP color and tested on a schedule to be determined by the officer in collaboration with the their supervisor

After being enrolled into the RDTP the defendant is required to telephone a toll free telephone number and follow the instructions which are reviewed with them when being enrolled into the program. The defendant enrolled into the RDTP telephones the toll free number every Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday after 6 p.m. and reports to Pretrial Services the very next day if his or her Color is selected for drug testing. The defendant is required to call the RDTP everyday since the color will change daily.

After successfully reporting for his or her drug test and testing negative for all illegal drugs we test for a period of time determined by our internal policy the defendant may have his color re-assigned to a color which reports in less often than the prior assigned color.

The goal of the program is to ensure that defendant are tested randomly, thereby ensuring the integrity of a drug testing program and providing defendant's with assistance and support in maintaining their sobriety.
